# Inaugural International Piano Teachers Seminar at Glenfern May 25 - 28, 2009

Style, Technique and Interpretation, an International Seminar for piano teachers, students and pianists was enjoyed by participants from Malaysia, Singapore, Thailand, together with some piano teachers from Melbourne. It was suitable for piano teachers at all levels, piano students and also amateur pianists and was directed, in Australia by Robert Chamberlain, and organised in South East Asia by Ms Lai Mei Kuen (The Talent Makers – Malaysia).

The Seminar provided information and cultural background to important periods of piano music, and gave participants the confidence to teach technique and style to their students. There was a mixture of lecture demonstrations and lessons/workshops in small groups. Teachers were helped to build confidence in their own playing skills with sessions on the *Tone Touch and Technique* books and on *Practice Strategies and Systematic Learning*. Early childhood education specialist John McCartin addressed issues in training children of various ages and *Encore Music Education* founder Mark Gibson, from Brisbane, worked with participants using the *Encore Smart System* of music education.

Participants were encouraged to prepare some teaching or performance items from the various style periods and/or some items from Max Cooke's *Tone, Touch and Technique* books.
